Publicity, Promotions and Publishing Committee Report

13 May 2010

Multi-Cultural Festival, Brockville

As previously reported, EOSARDA was asked by Cliff Lalonde of the Good Time Squares to assist with two demonstration dances that the club had been requested to perform at the Brockville Multi-Cultural Festival on the evenings of May 7 and 8.

Unfortunately the weekend in question was the same weekend as T&D so finding dancers who were available on either date proved difficult. Cliff was able to assemble a full square for the evening of Friday, May 7 but we had difficulty finding enough dancers for the Saturday evening spot. We were working on filling out the dancer lineup for Saturday when it was learned that the Caller for the event was no longer available. Efforts to find a last-minute replacement proved fruitless and ultimately we had to cancel the Saturday evening demo.

Cliff reports that as far as Friday evening was concerned:

- "the event went well ... in spite of near misses. The time was to be 10:00-10:30. By 9:20 only 6 dancer were present and the M.C. said we were going on early! The Caller and 2 more dancers arrived shortly thereafter and we were on stage by 9:35. The dancing was lively, on time, fun and varied.
- "The Master of Ceremonies read a presentation that I [Cliff] had prepared. It talked a little about Square Dance, EOSARDA, Round Dance, local and national dance numbers. Mollean handed out postcards listing local contact numbers...the presentation spoke about clubs from Cornwall to Ottawa.
- " So...it was an event that went well...but almost didn't happen.
- "Bea Singh [main cog of multi-cultural] was pleased and thought she would try Square Dancing in the Fall. A number of people in the audience were enthusiastic and hopefully, will come out in the Fall, as well.
- " In retrospect, I thought everyone was coming early but that was not so. I think [for future events] I would ask they come an hour early to be sure they are coming.
- " I am thinking of a pool of dancers that would volunteer to dance at events, if available. This pool would be accomplished dancers only. Dancing would be at least an hour duration, with audience participation. One place I have in mind locally is the Hardy Park pavilion. Exposure would not only be to locals but travellers on the water. I am thinking of an EOSARDA position Dance Coordinator. This person would have a list of available ACCOMPLISHED dancers who are willing to invest energy, talent, time to further dancing.
- " The next adventure is the Senior Athletes."

2010 Senior 55 + Games

As Cliff says in his report, the next big event in this region will be the 2010 Senior 55 + Games that are scheduled to take place at St. Lawrence College in Brockville from August 23 and 24. These games are expected to attract over 2,000 contestants and a large number of spectators.

Registration will take place on Monday, Aug. 23 and Tuesday, Aug. 24. The opening ceremonies and parade will be held Wednesday evening. Competitions will commence Wednesday morning. Competitions will continue from Aug. 24 to Saturday, Aug. 28, 2010 when closing ceremonies will take place.

Events will include golf, cribbage, curling, 5-pin bowling, contract bridge, swimming, track and field, hockey, duplicate bridge, Scrabble, slo pitch, tennis, darts, floor shuffleboard, horseshoes, eight-ball, table tennis, mini-marathon, lawn bowling, badminton, canoeing, triathlon, kayaking and archery.

A fishing tournament, digital photo contest, geo-caching scavenger hunt, BBQ, live entertainment, interpretive displays, nature walks, open water swim and other participatory opportunities will be scheduled and available for sign-up.

The Good Time Squares have been asked to set up an information booth from 9 am to 9pm on both Monday, August 23 and Tuesday, August 24. If we establish 3 hours/3 person shifts, this will require between 8 and 24 people and lots of handout material, including, but not limited to:

- EOSARDA post cards,
- lists of regional dance clubs offering beginner dance lessons (both Squares and Rounds)
- general information pamphlets on both Square and Round Dancing and
- -flyers promoting participation in the Thursday dance day .

Two free-standing banners would be a great addition to the booth.

Good Time Squares have also been take part in an Activity Day on Thursday, August 26. This will involve 2 squares of accomplished Mainstream dancers taking to the floor 3 times that day for a half-hour combined dance demo/spectator participation dance. The present schedule (which is subject to change) calls for dancing at 10:30am, 11:30am and 1:00pm. So if all dancers were to dance only once during the day, 48 people can be accommodated. If every dancer danced at all three times, then only 16 people will be needed. I am advised that Bob Summers has agreed to Call at the event.

This is a very important promotional opportunity for EOSARDA with excellent timing coming as it does just before Square and Round Dance Week 2010. I would like to see EOSARDA strongly support this event by helping with its planning, organizing and implementation and by providing financial assistance as required, up to a maximum of \$1,000 to permit the purchase of two free-standing banners and a large quantity of promotional brochures and flyers and to provide a small honorarium to the Caller for his hard work (\$100?).

We should also ask Federation to investigate the possibility of including Square and Round Dancing as regular events at future games. After all, Scrabble and duplicate bridge are already part of the games.

Hearing Enhancement Report

Report to the EOSARDA Board On Hearing Enhancement

I have created a flyer advertising Bulk Ordering of Hearing Enhancement Equipment. We have distributed the flyers, unfortunately at the end of the dance season. I have no way of knowing how many callers/cuers probably took the time to distribute it. I have attached a copy of the flyer.

As agreed upon at a previous EOSARDA Board Meeting, I will place one order on June 1, 2010. I have requested a \$50 CDN deposit from each person ordering. I will make sure the Transmitter Systems and the Receivers are in the hands of the buyers as soon as the order has arrived and I can make contact with them.

I would like to send a receipt for the deposit to each of the people who have ordered. I would like the EOSARDA Board's permission to buy stamps to place on the envelopes of those receipts that I have to mail.

Below is a summary of the orders that I have at this time.

Transmitter Systems

To date, I have orders (with deposits) for:

4 Hearing Enhancement Transmitter Systems (and the promise of one more). At this point, only one caller and one Round Dance Club/Cuer have ordered. The other two are for individuals.

The bulk pricing for these systems will be \$30 cheaper than the list price of \$197 US, making the cost just \$167 US for these people. If we get 7 orders, that price will drop to \$147. Note these prices do not include shipping, handling, PST, GST, and border handling charge.

Receivers

To date, we have orders (2 with deposits, 4 _ for EOSARDA, with <u>no</u> deposit) for 6 Hearing Enhancement Receivers.

The bulk pricing for these receivers will be \$10 cheaper than the list price of \$74.77 US, making the cost just \$64.77 US for these people. If we get 10 orders, that price will drop to \$57.77. Note these prices do not include shipping, handling, PST, GST, and border handling charge.
