Traditionally, this dance has focused on new dancers.

6.6. Club reports

Recurring themes:

- A small number of clubs report increasing numbers; a number of clubs report reduced numbers
- Clubs report that it is important to combine teaching with reviews, along with time to "just dance"
- Many dancers report being uncomfortable returning to dancing
- Some clubs are finding higher level dancers returning, and to varying degrees have new dancers attending, for at least a few sessions
- Clubs that have experimented with newer, modern and innovative advertising approaches report success over past attempts using "just the usual"
- Some clubs have introduced COVID protocols requiring standard measures such as vaccinations, masks, etc.
- Some clubs report difficulty getting all members to attend on a regular basis, and that it is difficult to encourage dancers to travel very far to dance
- While open houses have attracted new dancers, only a small proportion of those recruits remain active in the clubs
